AN ACT

To amend chapter 103, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to state employee health care.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 103, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 103.180, to read as follows:

103.180. The board shall commission a comprehensive study regarding how other states administer their state employee health care $\mathbf{2}$ plans. As part of the study, the board shall determine which states self-3 fund their state employee health care plans and determine whether 4 self-funding is a better alternative to fully insuring such plans through 5traditional insurance companies. If a state employee health care plan 6 is self-funded, the board shall also determine whether the state health 7 care plan purchases stop-loss coverage, reinsurance, or assumes all 8 9 financial risks related to the administration of the state health care plan. The study shall also survey which states allow other populations, 10 11 other than state employees, to participate in their respective state 12health care plans and whether the participation of other populations 13within their state health care plans has strengthened or weakened the 14 overall solvency of their plans. The board shall issue a report to the general assembly by January 1, 2010. The report shall include 15recommendations to the general assembly on how the state can improve 16 the Missouri Consolidated Health Care Plan based upon the board's 17survey of other state health care plans. The report may contain any 18 other recommendations relevant to improving the plan's mission of 19 providing health insurance to state employees and dependents. 20
