JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article III of the Constitution of Missouri, adding thereto one new section relating to prohibited use of public funds as to certain life sciences.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on
2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2010, or at a special
3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted
4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following
5 amendment to article III of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article III, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding
2 thereto one new section, to be known as section 38, to read as follows:

**Section 38. It shall be unlawful to expend, pay, or grant any
2 public funds for abortion services, human cloning, or prohibited human
3 research, as such terms were defined by the 92nd Missouri general
4 assembly in 2003, in section 196.1127, RSMo, L.2003, H.B. 688.**
