Dear Mr. Kerr:

During the past legislative session, the General Assembly passed HB 191, which provided for expanded tax credits. The number of actual jobs created as a direct result of this legislation is important information to have available to members of the General Assembly.

As such, as I did in August, I again respectfully request a detailed report of the current, not anticipated, number of jobs created because of these tax credits and the passage of HB 191. I note the authority to provide these tax credits has been effective since the legislation was signed into law by Governor Nixon. Furthermore, I ask to be advised on the number of tax credits issued by project and subsequently redeemed by Missouri businesses and the resulting actual jobs created; not anticipated.

I further request that in the future, my office is notified of each new job created as a result of HB 191 and or other tax credits or Economic Development programs.
