Senator Keaveny Announces Tax Credit For Assisting Abused and Neglected Children

JEFFERSON CITY – Missouri Sen. Joe Keaveny (D-St. Louis) is proud to announce that the Annie Malone Children and Family Service Center at 2612 Annie Malone Drive in St. Louis has received tax credits from the Missouri Department of Economic Development (DED).

The DED's Neighborhood Assistance Program approved \$216,821 in tax credits to the Annie Malone Children and Family Service Center. The center serves abused and neglected children throughout St. Louis and the 4th Senatorial District and provides various services, including residential treatment services, a transitional living program, a therapeutic school offering educational services to K-12 children, a teen crisis program, a crisis nursery program, and a parenting program.

"Annie Malone's first opened in 1888 and has been a refuge for children ever since," said Sen. Keaveny. "I'm very glad they are receiving these much needed funds, as they provide an invaluable service to this community."
