Citizens from 5th Senatorial District Appointed to Governor's Commissions

JEFFERSON CITY – Senator Robin Wright-Jones, D-St. Louis, proudly announces the addition of two citizens from the 5th Senatorial District to governor-appointed commissions: the State Lottery Commission and the Public Service Commission.

Mr. Jacque Land of St. Louis was recently appointed to serve on the <u>State Lottery Commission</u>, which is responsible for maximizing state revenues for public education through the creation and sale of lottery products that are consistent with the lottery commission's high standards. In addition, the commission establishes rules, approves an annual budget, and advises the panel's executive director.

One of the newest additions to the <u>Missouri Public Service Commission</u>, also from St. Louis, is Mr. Michael Kenney. The Public Service Commission works to ensure that regulated utility services are safe, of the highest quality, and delivered to Missourians in a timely manner and at reasonable rates. The commission is charged with conducting hearings in contested utility cases and producing decisions on those cases in a timely manner.

"Boards and commissions give our state's citizens a voice in their government," said Sen. Wright-Jones. "I am proud of Mr. Land and Mr. Kenney for their commitment to our state and their future growth within state government."
