Senator Wright-Jones Appointed to New Tax Credit Review Commission

JEFFERSON CITY – Senator Robin Wright-Jones, D-St. Louis, has been selected by Gov. Nixon to serve on the newly created Tax Credit Review Commission. The panel is charged with reviewing the state’s 61 tax credit programs and making recommendations to ensure efficiency and an increase return on tax-dollar investments. A total of 25 businesses, community and legislative leaders were appointed to work on the commission.

“As a current member of the Joint Committee on Tax Policy, which is responsible for studying and analyzing current and proposed tax policy in our state, I will feel right at home on this new commission,” said Sen.
