Senator Wright-Jones Commends Drury Plaza Hotel's 'Green Hotel' Certification

JEFFERSON CITY – Senator Robin Wright-Jones (D-St. Louis) recently recognized the Drury Plaza Hotel for its environmentally responsible efforts in achieving the “Green Hotel” certification from the Missouri Hotel and Lodging Association.
