Senator Green Selected as Minority Caucus Chairman

JEFFERSON CITY — Senator Timothy Green, D-Spanish Lake, today was selected by his peers to serve as Minority Caucus Chairman. Current and future members of the Missouri Senate met today (11-4) in their respective caucuses to select leaders for the 96th General Assembly, which begins in early January.

As caucus chairman, Sen. Green will preside over caucus meetings, which are composed of all members of the minority party. Senator Victor Callahan, D-Independence, was re-elected as minority floor leader. Other minority leadership positions elected today include assistant minority floor leader, which will be filled by Sen. Jolie Justus (D-Kansas City) and the minority caucus secretary position, which will be filled by Sen. Robin Wright-Jones (D-St. Louis).

"In this leadership position, I will continue my work to improve our state and to serve the people of the 13th Senatorial District," said Sen. Green. "I am pleased and thankful that my colleagues chose to elect me to this position, and I look forward to working with my peers and the entire Senate when the legislative session begins in two months."

The First Regular Session of the 96th General Assembly begins Jan. 5, 2011.
