Senator Frank Barnitz Announces Signing Memorandum of Understanding Between City of Salem and ProEnergy Services

JEFFERSON CITY — Senator Frank Barnitz, D-Lake Spring, today announced that the City of Salem and ProEnergy Services will be signing a Memorandum of Understanding. The partnership has been developed to explore the use of wood-fire power to fuel the region's power needs. Following the signing, Sen. Barnitz; Mayor Gary Brown; John Smeltzer, Vice President of ProEnergy Services; and Spectrum Consulting's Mike Mills will hold a public forum to allow members of the community to ask any questions they may have regarding the possible facility and wood-fire power.
