### **Stouffer to Announce Opposition to Tax Increase**

*State Senator Will Introduce Resolution to Reject Tax Increase on Landowners*

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, will conduct a press conference to announce his plan to reject a tax increase that has been proposed for Missouri landowners. He will be joined by leaders from the Missouri Farm Bureau tomorrow morning (1/12) to announce his intentions to file a Senate Concurrent Resolution rejecting a tax increase established by the Missouri Tax Commission.

Last month, the Missouri Tax Commission raised land valuations on productive farm land by 29 percent. By statute, the General Assembly has 60 legislative days to reject the tax commission's findings.

The press conference will be held at 9:30 a.m., tomorrow, January 12, 2010, in the Bingham Gallery located on the south side of the Senate Chamber (on the third floor of the State Capitol).
