Senator Bill Stouffer to Chair "Rebooting Government" Transportation Work Group

Panel Is One of Eight That Will Formulate Ideas to Streamline State Government

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, has been named to head the Transportation Work Group to help create ideas for restructuring Missouri government.

"In this tough economy, we have been given a true opportunity," Sen. Stouffer said. "We have the chance to overhaul the way state government works. Folks from all over the state have sent in their ideas and now, we'll take them and get the wheels turning on making government work better."

All eight work groups will meet throughout the day tomorrow (3/23) and discuss the more than 500 suggestions sent in via the <u>Rebooting Government</u> section on the Missouri Senate's <u>website</u>. Each panel will then submit five recommendations to the Senate President Pro Tem.

"Some of the ideas can be started right away and others will take more time," Sen. Stouffer said. "The bottom line is, we're going to take this once in a lifetime opportunity to do what you ask us to, and that's make government do a better job with the resources it has. Best of all, we can do this without raising anybody's taxes."
