Senator Bill Stouffer Named to New Committee Designed to Examine State Government Programs

Panel Assigned with Reduction and Reorganization of State Programs

JEFFERSON CITY — State Sen. Bill Stouffer, R-Napton, has been named to serve on the <u>Joint</u> <u>Committee on the Reduction and Reorganization of Programs within State Government</u>.

"I am looking forward to the task we have," Sen. Stouffer said. "The people have spoken. Now, it's time for a complete overhaul of how state government works. Obviously, there will be some programs that could be changed and others that may have to be eliminated."

Senator Stouffer is one of five senators and five state representatives who will serve on the panel. Hearing dates have not yet been set.

"We live in very interesting times," Sen. Stouffer said. "We started looking at how state government works earlier this year with the Missouri Senate's "<u>Rebooting Government</u>" efforts. Now, we have the chance to see what works — and what doesn't."
