Senator Pearce Recognized for Exceptional Service to Local Medical Clinic

JEFFERSON CITY—Senator David Pearce (R-Warrensburg) was recently honored by the Western Johnson County Medical Clinic (WJCMC) for his support of the non-profit clinic's efforts to provide medical services to the rural community of Kingsville and the surrounding area.

"It is an honor to be recognized by the Western Johnson County Medical Clinic, especially considering all of the fine work they do," Sen. Pearce said. "The clinic fulfills a critical need in the community by providing accessible and affordable health care to an area that may not otherwise have it."
