## Senator Pearce and Rep. Hoskins Speak at UCM eZone Meeting

JEFFERSON CITY—Senator David Pearce (R-Warrensburg) and Rep. Denny Hoskins (R-Warrensburg) last week (5/27) gave a legislative update during the eZone Outreach and Showcase and luncheon at the University of Central Missouri, sponsored by the Entrepreneurial Innovation and Development Corporation. The meeting brought together several Missouri business leaders and others with an interest in the state's economic development to discuss strategic plans for boosting business and creating jobs.

Senator Pearce and Rep. Hoskins were asked to address the crowd on the legislative accomplishments of the General Assembly this year.
