Senator David Pearce Hosts 31st Senatorial District State Representatives

JEFFERSON CITY—Senator David Pearce (R-Warrensburg) hosted the six state representatives that reside in the 31st Senatorial District for a legislative dinner at Powell Gardens on November 21, 2010. All six representatives were in attendance, including Rep. Scott Largent (R-120), Rep. Denny Hoskins (R-121), Rep. Mike McGhee (R-122), Rep.
