AN ACT

To amend chapter 32, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the authority of the department of revenue to provide certain statutory notifications by electronic mail, with an effective date.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 32, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 32.081, to read as follows:

32.081. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the director of revenue may transmit any notification required under $\mathbf{2}$ chapters 143, 144, 301, 302, 303, 304, 306, 454, 544, 571, and 577 by 3 4 electronic mail if the intended recipient of the notice has provided an electronic mail address to the department and consented to the receipt 56 of notifications through the electronic mail address provided. Such 7 electronic notification shall be in lieu of and in full satisfaction of any requirement to provide notification by ordinary mail. Any person who 8 has elected to receive such electronic notifications may later request 9 that the notifications be provided by ordinary mail. 10

2. The director of revenue may promulgate rules and regulations 11 12to implement this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term 13is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority 14 delegated in this subsection shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, if 1516applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly 17pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to 18disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, 19

- 20 then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or
- 21 adopted after August 28, 2010, shall be invalid and void.

Section B. The enactment of section 32.081 of section A of this act shall 2 become effective January 1, 2011.
