**AN ACT**

To repeal section 227.303, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof four new sections relating to memorial highway designations.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 227.303, RSMo, is repealed and four new sections  
2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 227.303, 227.365, 227.405, and  
3 227.408, to read as follows:

227.303. The portion of interstate highway 70 within a city not within a  
2 county to the border with the state of Illinois shall be designated the "Mark  
3 [McGwire] Twain Highway".

227.365. **The portion of Lindbergh Boulevard located in St. Louis  
2 County, from its intersection with Lemay Ferry Road, to the highway's  
3 connection with Barracksview Road, shall be designated as the "Dave  
4 Sinclair Memorial Highway". The department of transportation shall  
5 erect and maintain appropriate signs designating such highway, with  
6 the costs for such designation to be paid for by private donations.**

227.405. **The portion of Interstate 44 in St. Louis County  
2 beginning from its intersection with South Geyer Road and proceeding  
3 east to its intersection with South Elm Avenue shall be designated the  
4 "Police Officer Ernest M. Brockman Sr. Memorial Highway". The  
5 department of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate  
6 signs designating such highway, with the costs to be paid for by private  
7 donations.**

**EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.**

227.408. The portion of state highway 53 in Butler County from  
2 the city limits of Qulin to one mile south of the city limits shall be  
3 designated the "Johnny Lee Hays Memorial Highway". The department  
4 of transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs  
5 designating such highway, with the costs to be paid for by private  
6 donations.
