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AN ACT

To repeal section 140.100, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to penalties for tax-delinquent lands.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 140.100, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 140.100, to read as follows:

140.100. 1. Each tract of land in the back tax book, in addition to the amount of tax delinquent, shall be charged with a penalty of eighteen percent of each year's delinquency except that the penalty on lands redeemed prior to sale
