AN ACT

To amend chapter 227, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to conducting a study on dangerous rural lettered highways in Missouri.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 227, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 227.700, to read as follows:

227.700. The director of the department of public safety is hereby

2 instructed to conduct a study regarding the safety of rural lettered

3 highways in Missouri. In addition to studying the overall safety of

4 Missouri's rural lettered highways, the study shall specifically include

a report on Missouri's top ten dangerous rural lettered highways. The

6 report shall include recommendations on how to improve the safety of

7 rural lettered highways. The director of the department of public

8 safety shall issue the report containing the recommendations to the

general assembly and the director of the department of transportation

10 no later than February 14, 2011.
