## AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to special license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 301.3160, to read as follows:

301.3160. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person, after an annual payment of an emblem-use fee to  $\mathbf{2}$ the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, may receive special license 3 plates for any vehicle the person owns, either solely or jointly, other 4 than an apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle 5 licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight. The 6 National Multiple Sclerosis Society hereby authorizes the use of its 7 official emblem to be affixed on multi-year personalized license plates 8 as provided in this section. Any contribution to the National Multiple 9 Sclerosis Society derived from this section, except reasonable 10 administrative costs, shall be used solely for the purposes of the 11 National Multiple Sclerosis Society. Any vehicle owner may annually 12apply for the use of the emblem. 13

2. Upon annual application and payment of a twenty-five dollar 1415emblem-use contribution to the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society shall issue to the vehicle owner, 1617without further charge, an emblem-use authorization statement, which shall be presented by the vehicle owner to the director of revenue at 18the time of registration. Upon presentation of the annual statement 19 20and payment of a twenty-five dollar fee in addition to the regular registration fees, and presentation of any documents which may be 21

required by law, the director of revenue shall issue to the vehicle 2223owner a special license plate which shall bear the emblem of the National Multiple Sclerosis Society. Such license plates shall be made 2425with fully reflective material with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as 26prescribed by section 301.130. In addition, upon such set of license 27plates shall be inscribed, in lieu of the words "SHOW-ME STATE", the 28words "JOIN THE MOVEMENT". Notwithstanding the provisions of 2930section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for the personalization of license plates issued pursuant to this section. 31

323. A vehicle owner who was previously issued a plate with the National Multiple Sclerosis Society's emblem authorized by this section, 33but who does not provide an emblem-use authorization statement at a 34subsequent time of registration, shall be issued a new plate which does 35not bear the National Multiple Sclerosis Society's emblem, as otherwise 36 37provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules and regulations for the enforcement of this section, and shall design all 3839necessary forms required by this section.

404. Prior to the issuance of a National Multiple Sclerosis Society's specialty plate authorized under this section the department of revenue 4142must be in receipt of an application, as prescribed by the director, which shall be accompanied by a list of at least two hundred potential 4344applicants who plan to purchase the specialty plate, the proposed art design for the specialty license plate, and an application fee, not to 45exceed five thousand dollars, to defray the department's cost for 46issuing, developing, and programming the implementation of the 4748specialty plate. Once the plate design is approved, the director of revenue shall not authorize the manufacture of the material to produce 49such specialized license plates with the individual seal, logo, or emblem 50until such time as the director has received two hundred applications, 51the twenty-five dollar specialty plate fee per application, and 52emblem-use statements, if applicable, and other required documents or 53fees for such plates. 54
