## AN ACT

To authorize the conveyance of certain state properties, with emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. 1. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered

Section 3. 1. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered to sell, transfer, grant, convey, remise, release and forever quitclaim all interest of the state of Missouri in real property located at the Missouri Lottery Headquarters, Jefferson City, Cole County, Missouri, to owners of certain private property for the purpose of vacating an easement more particularly described as follows:

Section A. Because immediate action is necessary to continue economic development efforts, sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act are deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and safety, and are hereby declared to be an emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.

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
