AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to local government week.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 9.171, to read as follows:

9.171. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting
