AN ACT

To amend chapter 32, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the authority of the department of revenue to provide certain statutory notifications by electronic mail, with an effective date.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 32, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 32.081, to read as follows:

32.081. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the

2 director of revenue may transmit any notification required under

 $3 \quad chapters \ 143, \ 144, \ 301, \ 302, \ 303, \ 304, \ 306, \ 454, \ 544, \ 571, \ and \ 577 \ by$

4 electronic mail if the intended recipient of the notice has provided an

5 electronic mail address to the department and consented to the receipt

6 of notifications through the electronic mail address provided. Such

7 electronic notification shall be in lieu of and in full satisfaction of any

8 requirement to provide notification by ordinary mail. Any person who

9 has elected to receive such electronic notifications may later request

10 that the notifications be provided by ordinary mail.

2. The director of revenue may promulgate rules and regulations

12 to implement this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term

13 is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority

delegated in this subsection shall become effective only if it complies

15 with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, if

applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are

7 nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly

- 18 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to
- 19 disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional,
- 20 then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or
- 21 adopted after August 28, 2010, shall be invalid and void.

Section B. The enactment of section 32.081 of section A of this act shall

2 become effective January 1, 2011.
