As part of the College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007, the US Congress created the College Access Challenge Grant Program. This section provides funding for the University of Missouri System. The Missouri State General Assembly passed the Geyer Act in February of 1839 that ordered, in part, "A University is hereby instituted in this State". At this time, the University of Missouri was the only institution of higher learning west of the Mississippi River. The Missouri River was then the State's main artery of commerce and transportation and it was determined the University should be located in one of several central Missouri counties for greatest ease of access. Boone County was able to amass the greatest money and land "subscriptions" (just over \$118,000) to provide for construction and support of the University grew over the following decades to hold a place of regional and national distinction. In the early 1960's, an effort was made to more fully address the higher education needs in Kansas City and St. Louis. The University of Missouri implemented its plan to expand to a four-campus system at Columbia, Rolla, St. Louis and Kansas City in 1963.
