## AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto two new sections relating to specialized license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto two new 2 sections, to be known as sections 301.477 and 301.4006, to read as follows:

301.477. 1. Any person who has been awarded the combat action badge may apply for special personalized motor vehicle license plates for any vehicle the person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight.

- 2. Any such person shall make application for the special license plates on a form provided by the director of revenue and furnish such proof as a recipient of the combat action badge as the director may require.
- 3. The director shall then issue license plates bearing the words 10 "COMBAT ACTION" in place of the words "SHOW-ME STATE" in a form 11 prescribed by the director, except that such license plates shall be 12 13 made with fully reflective material, shall have a white background with 14 a blue and red configuration at the discretion of the director, shall be 15 clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as 16 prescribed by section 301.130. Such plates shall also bear an image of 17 the combat action badge.
- 4. There shall be an additional fee of fifteen dollars charged for each set of special combat action badge license plates issued pursuant to this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no

additional fee shall be charged for the personalization of license plates 2122issued pursuant to this section.

- 23 5. There shall be no limit on the number of license plates any person qualified under this section may obtain so long as each set of 2425 license plates issued under this section is issued for vehicles owned solely or jointly by such person.  $^{26}$
- 6. License plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section shall not be transferable to any other person except that any registered 28co-owner of the motor vehicle shall be entitled to operate the motor vehicle with such plates for the duration of the year licensed in the 30 event of the death of the qualified person.
  - 7. The director may consult with the Missouri national guard or any other organization which represents the interests of persons receiving combat action badges when formulating the design for the special license plates described in this section.
- 36 8. The director shall make all necessary rules and regulations for the administration of this section, and shall design all necessary forms 37 38 required by this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is 39 defined in section 536.010 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, if applicable, section 41536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of 4243 the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule 44are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking 45authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2011, shall 46 be invalid and void.
  - 301.4006. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person, after an annual payment of an emblem-use fee to the Nixa Education Foundation, may receive personalized speciality license plates for any vehicle owned, either solely or jointly, other than an apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand pounds gross weight. The Nixa Education Foundation hereby authorizes the use of its official emblem to be affixed on multi-year personalized speciality license plates as provided in this section. Any contribution to the Nixa Education Foundation derived from this section, except reasonable administrative costs, shall

be used solely for the purposes of the Nixa Education Foundation. Any
 person may annually apply for the use of the emblem.

13 2. Upon annual application and payment of a fifteen dollar emblem-use contribution to the Nixa Education Foundation, the Nixa 14 Education Foundation shall issue to the vehicle owner, without further 15 charge, an emblem-use authorization statement, which shall be 16 17 presented by the vehicle owner to the director of revenue at the time of registration. Upon presentation of the annual emblem-use 18 19 authorization statement and payment of a fifteen dollar fee in addition to the regular registration fees, and presentation of any documents 20 which may be required by law, the director of revenue shall issue to the 2122vehicle owner a personalized speciality license plate which shall bear the emblem of the Nixa Education Foundation. Such license plates 23shall be made with fully reflective material with a common color 24scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be 25aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. In addition, 26 upon each set of license plates shall be inscribed, in lieu of the words 27 28 "SHOW-ME STATE", the words "NIXA EDUCATION 29 FOUNDATION". Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no 30 additional fee shall be charged for the personalized specialty plates 31 issued under this section.

3. A vehicle owner who was previously issued a plate with the Nixa Education Foundation's emblem authorized by this section, but who does not provide an emblem-use authorization statement at a subsequent time of registration, shall be issued a new plate which does not bear the Nixa Education Foundation's emblem, as otherwise provided by law. The director of revenue shall make necessary rules and regulations for the enforcement of this section, and shall design all necessary forms required by this section.

4. Prior to the issuance of a Nixa Education Foundation 40 speciality plate authorized under this section, the department of 41 revenue must be in receipt of an application, as prescribed by the 42director, which shall be accompanied by a list of at least two hundred 43potential applicants who plan to purchase the speciality plate, the 44 proposed art design for the specialty license plate, and an application 45 fee, not to exceed five thousand dollars, to defray the department's cost 46 for issuing, developing, and programming the implementation of the 47

specialty plate. Once the plate design is approved, the director of revenue shall not authorize the manufacture of the material to produce such personalized specialty license plates with the individual seal, logo, or emblem until such time as the director has received two hundred applications, the fifteen dollar specialty plate fee per application, and emblem-use statements, if applicable, and other required documents or fees for such plates.
