AN ACT

To repeal sections 172.030 and 174.450, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to higher education governing boards.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 172.030 and 174.450, RSMo, are repealed and two 2 new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 172.030 and 3 174.450, to read as follows:

172.030. The board of curators of the University of the state of Missouri shall hereafter consist of nine members, who shall be appointed by the governor, by and with the advice and consent of the senate; provided, that [not more than one person] **at least one but no more than two** shall be appointed upon said board from [the same] **each** congressional district, and no person shall be appointed a curator who shall not be a citizen of the United States, and who shall not have been a resident of the state of Missouri two years next prior to his appointment. Not more than five curators shall belong to any one political party.

174.450. 1. Except as provided in subsection 2 and subsection 6 of this section, the governing board of Central Missouri State University, Missouri State $\mathbf{2}$ 3 University, Missouri Southern State University, Missouri Western State University, and of each other public institution of higher education which, 4 $\mathbf{5}$ through the procedures established in subdivision (7) or (8) of section 173.030, is charged with a statewide mission shall be a board of governors consisting of eight 6 7members, composed of seven voting members and one nonvoting member as provided in sections 174.453 and 174.455, who shall be appointed by the governor 8 9 of Missouri, by and with the advice and consent of the senate. No person shall 10 be appointed a voting member who is not a citizen of the United States and who

has not been a resident of the state of Missouri for at least two years immediately 11 12prior to such appointment. Not more than four voting members shall belong to any one political party. The appointed members of the board of regents serving 1314on the date of the statutory mission change shall become members of the board of governors on the effective date of the statutory mission change and serve until 1516the expiration of the terms for which they were appointed. The board of regents 17of any such institution shall be abolished on the effective date of the statutory 18mission change, as prescribed in subdivision (7) or (8) of section 173.030.

192. The governing board of Missouri State University, a public institution of higher education charged with a statewide mission in public affairs, shall be 20a board of governors of ten members, composed of nine voting members and one 21nonvoting member, who shall be appointed by the governor, by and with the 22advice and consent of the senate. The nonvoting member shall be a student 2324selected in the same manner as prescribed in section 174.055. [No more than one voting member] At least one but no more than two voting members shall 25be appointed to the board from [the same] each congressional district, and every 26member of the board shall be a citizen of the United States, and a resident of this 27state for at least two years prior to his or her appointment. No more than five 28voting members shall belong to any one political party. The term of office of the 2930 governors shall be six years. The voting members of the board of governors 31serving on August 28, 2005, shall serve until the expiration of the terms for which 32they were appointed. For those voting members appointed after August 28, 2005, 33 the term of office will be established in a manner where no more than three terms shall expire in a given year. The term of office for those appointed hereafter shall 34end January first in years ending in an odd number. 35

36 3. If a voting member of the board of governors of Missouri State 37 University is found by unanimous vote of the other governors to have moved such 38 governor's residence from the district from which such governor was appointed, 39 then the office of such governor shall be forfeited and considered vacant.

40 4. Should the total number of Missouri congressional districts be altered,
41 all members of the board of governors of Missouri State University shall be
42 allowed to serve the remainder of the term for which they were appointed.

5. Should the boundaries of any congressional districts be altered in a
manner that displaces a member of the board of governors of Missouri State
University from the congressional district from which the member was appointed,
the member shall be allowed to serve the remainder of the term for which the

47 member was appointed.

486. The governing board of Missouri Southern State University shall be a board of governors consisting of nine members, composed of eight voting members 4950and one nonvoting member as provided in sections 174.453 and 174.455, who shall be appointed by the governor of Missouri, by and with the advice and 51consent of the senate. No person shall be appointed a voting member who is not 52a citizen of the United States and who has not been a resident of the state of 53Missouri for at least two years immediately prior to such appointment. Not more 54than four voting members shall belong to any one political party. 55
