## AN ACT

To repeal sections 478.711 and 483.420, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the circuit court of Cape Girardeau County.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 478.711 and 483.420, RSMo, are repealed and two new

- 2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 478.711 and 483.420, to
- 3 read as follows:

478.711. 1. Within Cape Girardeau County the circuit court [shall] may

- 2 hold court in the courthouses at Jackson and at Cape Girardeau, and while
- 3 holding court at Jackson may be known as the "Circuit Court of Cape Girardeau
- 4 County at Jackson" and while holding court at Cape Girardeau may be known as
- 5 the "Circuit Court of Cape Girardeau County at Cape Girardeau". All matters
- 3 which are handled by circuit judges or associate circuit judges of the circuit court
- 7 of Cape Girardeau County may be handled at either of the locations.
- 8 2. The probate division of the circuit court of Cape Girardeau County
- 9 [shall] may maintain an office at the courthouse in Jackson and an office at the
- 10 courthouse in Cape Girardeau.

483.420. The circuit clerk of Cape Girardeau County [shall] may

2 maintain and staff offices at the courthouses in Jackson and Cape Girardeau.
