AN ACT

To amend chapter 392, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to telecommunications.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 392, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 392.461, to read as follows:

392.461. A telecommunications company shall not be required to comply with rules established by the commission which include provisions already mandated by the Federal Communications Commission, including but not limited to, federal rules regarding customer proprietary network information and slamming and cramming, and rules relating to the installation, provisioning, or termination of retail service. Notwithstanding other provisions of this chapter or chapter 386, a telecommunications company shall not be required to file any tariffs or schedules of rates, rentals, or charges for service with the commission for the offering of residential and business retail services sold to end user customers.
