AN ACT

To repeal sections 128.346 and 128.348, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to the composition of congressional districts.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 128.346 and 128.348, RSMo, are repealed and two new

- 2 sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 128.346 and 128.348, to
- 3 read as follows:

128.346. The districts established by the provisions of sections 128.400 to

- 2 128.440 for the election of representatives to the Congress of the United States
- 3 shall be effective beginning with election to the 108th Congress and through
- 4 the election of the 112th Congress. The districts established by the
- 5 provisions of this act for the election of representatives to the Congress
- 6 of the United States shall be effective beginning with the election to the
- 7 113th Congress.

128.348. The state of Missouri is hereby divided into nine congressional

- 2 districts. Effective with the election for the 113th Congress, the state of
- 3 Missouri shall consist of eight congressional districts. The legal voters
- 4 of each district shall elect one member of Congress of the United States.
