AN ACT

To amend chapter 36, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to a four-day work week for state employees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 36, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 36.145, to read as follows:

36.145. 1. Full-time employment for all employees subject to this
chapter shall be fixed at forty hours within a four-day period from 7:00
a.m. until 6:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.

2. The division of personnel within the office of administration, in conjunction with the officer or agent within each agency having the authority to make appointments to positions within such agency, shall restablish working hours other than those specified in subsection 1 of this section for essential personnel required for the security, safety, or necessary physical operation of the agency.

3. The implementation of the four-day work week established
under this section shall be completed by January 1, 2012.

124. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 13536.010 that is created under the authority delegated in this section 14shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, if applicable, section 536.028. This 15section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers 16vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to 17delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are 18subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking 1920authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2011, shall be invalid and void. 21
