AN ACT

To amend chapter 620, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to workforce development.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 620, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new

section, to be known as section 620.025, to read as follows: 620.025. No workforce development agency shall knowingly omit

an entity with whom it has a contract within any bidding process. Any

3 workforce development agency that knowingly omits such entity from

the bidding process shall repay the entity an amount equal to twenty-

five percent of the total cost of the project as recovery for loss of

6 opportunity due to the omission. As used in this section, "knowingly"

means having actual knowledge of or acting with deliberate ignorance

or reckless disregard for the prohibition involved.
