## AN ACT

To amend chapter 208, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to MO HealthNet managed care data.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 208, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 208.440, to read as follows:

**208.440. 1. By December 31, 2011, and updated once per calendar quarter, each MO HealthNet managed care organization, as such term is defined in section 208.431, shall provide to the MO HealthNet division all utilization, access, and spending data for the cost of care to each MO HealthNet participant covered under the organization. Such data shall:**

**(1) Be in the form of all payments made to health care providers, as such term is defined in subdivision (20) of section 376.1350, for services rendered to MO HealthNet participants;**

**(2) Identify claim-specific data for each patient service or procedure; and**

**(3) Include any other information the MO HealthNet division may require through the promulgation of rules to meet the requirements of this section.**

**2. The department of social services shall promulgate rules to develop the provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536, and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the effective date, or to**

23 **then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or**  
24 **adopted after August 28, 2011, shall be invalid and void.**

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
