## AN ACT

To repeal section 571.070, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the crime of unlawful possession of a firearm, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 571.070, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 571.070, to read as follows:

571.070. 1. A person commits the crime of unlawful possession of a

- 2 firearm if such person knowingly has any firearm in his or her possession and:
- 3 (1) Such person has been convicted of a felony under the laws of this
- state, or of a crime under the laws of any state or of the United States which, if
- 5 committed within this state, would be a felony; or
- 6 (2) Such person is on probation for a felony offense under the
- 7 laws of this state, or for a crime under the laws of any state or of the
- 8 United States, which if committed within this state, would be a felony;
- 9 **or**
- 10 (3) Such person is a fugitive from justice, is habitually in an intoxicated
- 11 or drugged condition, or is currently adjudged mentally incompetent.
- 12 2. Unlawful possession of a firearm is a class C felony.
- 13 3. The provisions of subdivision (1) of subsection 1 of this section shall not
- 14 apply to the possession of an antique firearm.
