AN ACT

To repeal section 21.400, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to subpoenas issued by the general assembly.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 21.400, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 21.400, to read as follows:

21.400. Subpoenas for witnesses **and the production of records** shall
2 be issued at the request of any member of [either house] **the senate or the**
3 **house of representatives**, or the party accused, or any member of any
4 committee; and all process awarded by the senate or house of representatives, and
5 subpoenas and other process for witnesses whose attendance is required by either
6 the senate or the house, or before any committee, shall be under the hand of the
7 [president] **lieutenant governor, president pro tem**, or the speaker and
8 attested by the secretary or chief clerk, as the case may be, and shall be executed
9 by the sergeant at arms of such house, or by a special messenger appointed for
10 that purpose.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
