AN ACT

To amend chapter 324, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to notifying employers regarding the licensing status of employees.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 324, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 324.014, to read as follows:

324.014. Any board, commission, committee, council, or office within the division of professional registration shall notify any known current employer of a change in a licensee's license and discipline status. An employer may provide a list of current licensed employees and make a request in writing to the board, commission, committee, council, or office within the division of professional registration responsible for the licensee's license, to be notified upon a change in the licensing status of any such licensed employee. Nothing in this section shall be construed as requiring the board, commission, committee, council, or office within the division of professional
