## AN ACT

To repeal section 226.095, RSMo, relating to the abolishment of mandatory arbitration in negligence actions where the department of transportation is a defendant.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 226.095, RSMo, is repealed, to read as follows:

2           [226.095. Upon request of the plaintiff in a negligence  
3           action against the department of transportation as defendant, the  
4           case shall be arbitrated by a panel of three arbiters pursuant to the  
          provisions of chapter 435.]

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in this bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.
