AN ACT

To amend chapter 304, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to automated traffic enforcement systems.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 304, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 304.850, to read as follows:

304.850. 1. In jurisdictions utilizing automated traffic enforcement systems, any fine imposed for a violation detected through the use of an automatic traffic enforcement system shall go to the local school district where the violation occurred to be used for transportation purposes. The portion of the fine distributed to the local school district shall not be distributed through the school funding mechanism of section 163.031.

8 2. For purposes of this section, an "automated traffic enforcement system" means a camera or optical device designed to 9 record images that depict the motor vehicle, the motor vehicle 10 operator, the license plate of the motor vehicle or other images to 11 establish evidence that the motor vehicle or its operator is not in 1213compliance with a law, ordinance, or regulation. Automated traffic 14enforcement systems shall also include automated speed enforcement systems. As used in this section, the term "automated speed 1516enforcement system" means a device with one or more motor vehicle sensors, including, but not limited to, photographic devices, radar 17devices, laser devices, or other electrical or mechanical devices, 18 designed to record the speed of a motor vehicle and to obtain a clear 19photograph or other recorded image of the motor vehicle and the motor 20

- 21 vehicle's license plate, which automatically produces one or more
- photographs, one or more microphotographs, a videotape, or other recorded image of a motor vehicle at the time it is used or operated in
- 24 violation of the posted speed limit.
