JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment repealing section 8 of article IX of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section in lieu thereof relating to the prohibition of public aid for religious purposes and institutions.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on 2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2012, or at a special 3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted 4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following 5 amendment to article IX of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Section 8, article IX, Constitution of Missouri, is repealed and 2 one new section adopted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 8, to read as 3 follows:

Section 8. [Neither the general assembly, nor any county, city, town, $\mathbf{2}$ township, school district or other municipal corporation, shall ever make an appropriation or pay from any public fund whatever, anything in aid of any 3 4 religious creed, church or sectarian purpose, or to help to support or sustain any private or public school, academy, seminary, college, university, or other 56 institution of learning controlled by any religious creed, church or sectarian 7 denomination whatever; nor shall any grant or donation of personal property or 8 real estate ever be made by the state, or any county, city, town, or other municipal corporation, for any religious creed, church, or sectarian purpose 9 whatever] Other provisions of this constitution to the contrary 10 notwithstanding, nothing shall prohibit the enactment of legislation 11

12pertaining to any education program, funding, or other support to benefit children attending any public or nonpublic Missouri elementary 13or secondary school, so long as such legislation complies with the 14requirements of the First Amendment to the United States Constitution. 15Section B. Pursuant to chapter 116, RSMo, and other applicable constitutional provisions and laws of this state allowing the general assembly to $\mathbf{2}$ 3 adopt ballot language for the submission of a joint resolution to the voters of this state, the official ballot title of the amendment proposed in section A shall be as 4 follows: $\mathbf{5}$

6 "Shall the Constitution of the State of Missouri be amended to allow the 7 enactment of legislation pertaining to education programs for children attending 8 Missouri public or nonpublic elementary or secondary schools while ensuring and 9 safeguarding separation of Church and State as required by the First Amendment 10 of the U.S. Constitution?"
