## AN ACT

To amend chapter 208, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to food stamps.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 208, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 208.1000, to read as follows:

208.1000. 1. Pursuant to 7 C.F.R. section 274.10(b), the

- 2 department of social services shall request that the Department of 3 Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) mandate the use of
- 4 photo identification for continued eligibility in the food stamp program
- 5 administered in Missouri. Upon six months after approval of the
- 6 request by FNS, the department shall issue a photo identification card
- 7 to each eligible household as proof of food stamp eligibility. Upon
- 8 request, a household member, or the household's authorized
- 9 representative, shall present the photo identification card at issuance
- 10 points, retail food stores, or meal services when exchanging benefits for
- 11 eligible food.
- 2. The department shall promulgate rules for the use of photo
- 13 identification cards required under this section, including rules for
- 14 whether the department shall:
- 15 (1) Issue separate photo identification cards to other eligible
- 16 household members or the household's authorized representative; or
- 17 (2) List such additional persons on the photo identification card 18 issued to the eligible household.
- 3. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section
- 20 536.010 that is created under the authority delegated in this section
- 21 shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of

the provisions of chapter 536, and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536, to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2012, shall be invalid and void.
