## AN ACT

To amend chapter 376, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to health insurance.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 376, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 376.393, to read as follows:

376.393. 1. As used in this section, the following terms shall mean:

- 3 (1) "Health carrier", the same meaning as such term is defined in 4 section 376.1350;
- 5 (2) "Provider", the same meaning as such term is defined in 6 section 376.1350, and in addition, licensed pharmacies and home health 7 agencies.
- 8 2. Each health carrier shall provide each contracted provider with access to the health carrier's standard fee schedule, specific to the provider's geographic area, through a secure website. Such fee 10 schedule shall reflect the current payment rates for all goods and 11 services pertinent to the provider's practice or business, defined by 12procedure codes, diagnosis related groups, or defined by another 13 payment mechanism, and all contracted providers in such geographic 15 area shall be paid for the goods and services provided at such rates, 16 unless different rates have been specifically agreed upon contractually 17with an individual provider, or at rates pursuant to subsection 3 of this 18 section for providers contracted pursuant to such subsection. In no case shall the standard fee schedule include a rate for a specific good 20 or service that is less than the lowest rate individually contracted for by the providers of such good or service in the applicable geographic

22area if all the providers in such area, excluding those contracted pursuant to subsection 3 of this section, have individually contracted to be paid at different rates for such good or service. 24

3. No health carrier, or any of its subsidiaries, networks, contractors, or subcontractors, shall refuse to contract with any 2627Missouri provider who is located within the geographic coverage area of a health benefit plan and who is willing to meet the terms and 28conditions for provider participation established for such health 29benefit plan, including the MO HealthNet and Medicare programs, if 31 such provider is willing, as a term of such contract, to be paid at rates 32 equal to ninety-nine percent of the standard rates provided pursuant 33 to subsection 2 of this section.
