## AN ACT

To repeal section 514.060, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to a prevailing defendant recovering litigation costs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 514.060, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 514.060, to read as follows:

514.060. In all civil actions, or proceedings of any kind, the [party] prevailing defendant or defendants shall recover [his] their costs and attorney's fees against the other party, except in those cases in which a 4 different provision is made by law. In determining whether the defendant prevailed, the court shall confer prevailing defendant status based 6 upon each allegation and prayer for relief sought by plaintiff standing alone. A "prevailing defendant" shall include dismissal, grant of summary judgment, or judgment bу t h e court 9 defendant. "Prevailing defendant" shall not include voluntary dismissal 10 by the plaintiff prior to the time period for filing a motion to dismiss 11 by the defendant. This section shall apply despite any provision of 12 sections 514.070 to section 514.090 to the contrary.
