AN ACT

To repeal section 137.1018, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the extension of the sunset on the rolling stock tax credit.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 137.1018, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 137.1018, to read as follows:

137.1018. 1. The commission shall ascertain the statewide average rate

- 2 of property taxes levied the preceding year, based upon the total assessed
- 3 valuation of the railroad and street railway companies and the total property
- 4 taxes levied upon the railroad and street railway companies. It shall determine
- 5 total property taxes levied from reports prescribed by the commission from the
- 6 railroad and street railway companies. Total taxes levied shall not include
- 7 revenues from the surtax on subclass three real property.
- 8 2. The commission shall report its determination of average property tax
- 9 rate for the preceding year, together with the taxable distributable assessed
- 10 valuation of each freight line company for the current year to the director no later
- 11 than October first of each year.
- 12 3. Taxes on property of such freight line companies shall be collected at
- 13 the state level by the director on behalf of the counties and other local public
- 14 taxing entities and shall be distributed in accordance with sections 137.1021 and
- 15 137.1024. The director shall tax such property based upon the distributable
- 16 assessed valuation attributable to Missouri of each freight line company, using
- 17 the average tax rate for the preceding year of the railroad and street railway
- 18 companies certified by the commission. Such tax shall be due and payable on or
- 19 before December thirty-first of the year levied and, if it becomes delinquent, shall

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- 20 be subject to a penalty equal to that specified in section 140.100.
- 214. (1) As used in this subsection, the following terms mean:
- 22 (a) "Eligible expenses", expenses incurred in this state to manufacture, 23maintain, or improve a freight line company's qualified rolling stock;
- 24(b) "Qualified rolling stock", any freight, stock, refrigerator, or other 25 railcars subject to the tax levied under this section.
- 26 (2) For all taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2009, a freight 27line company shall, subject to appropriation, be allowed a credit against the tax levied under this section for the applicable tax year. The tax credit amount shall 28 be equal to the amount of eligible expenses incurred during the calendar year 29immediately preceding the tax year for which the credit under this section is 30 claimed. The amount of the tax credit issued shall not exceed the freight line 31 company's liability for the tax levied under this section for the tax year for which 32 33 the credit is claimed.
- (3) A freight line company may apply for the credit by submitting to the 34 commission an application in the form prescribed by the state tax commission. 35
- 36 (4) Subject to appropriation, the state shall reimburse, on an annual basis, any political subdivision of this state for any decrease in revenue due to the 37 provisions of this subsection. 38
 - 5. [Pursuant to section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset act:
- 40 (1) The provisions of the new program authorized under this section shall automatically sunset six years after August 28, 2008, unless reauthorized by an 41 42act of the general assembly; and
- 43 (2) If such program is reauthorized, the program authorized under this section shall automatically sunset twelve years after the effective date of the 44 reauthorization of this section; and 45
- (3) This section shall terminate on September first of the calendar year immediately following the calendar year in which the program authorized under this section is sunset.] Pursuant to section 23.253 of the Missouri sunset 48act, the provisions of the program authorized under subsection 4 of this 49 section are hereby reauthorized and shall automatically sunset on 50August 28, 2021.
