## AN ACT

To repeal section 41.050, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the state militia.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 41.050, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted  
2 in lieu thereof, to be known as section 41.050, to read as follows:

41.050. The militia of the state shall include all able-bodied citizens and  
2 all other able-bodied residents, who, in the case of the unorganized militia and  
3 the Missouri reserve military force, shall be more than seventeen years of age and  
4 not more than sixty-four, and such other persons as may upon their own  
5 application be enrolled or commissioned therein, and who, in the case of the  
6 organized militia, shall be within the age limits and possess the physical and  
7 mental qualifications prescribed by law or regulations for the reserve components  
8 of the armed forces of the United States, except that this section shall not be  
9 construed to require militia service of any persons specifically exempted by the  
10 laws of the United States or the state of Missouri. **The maximum age**  
11 **requirement may be waived by the adjutant general on a case-by-case**  
12 **basis.**
