## AN ACT

To amend chapters 192, 208, 376, and 630, RSMo, by adding thereto five new sections relating to social service programs.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapters 192, 208, 376, and 630, RSMo, are amended by

- 2 adding thereto five new sections, to be known as sections 192.328, 208.1000,
- 3 217.072, 376.687, and 630.106, to read as follows:

192.328. Because of the importance of social service programs in

- 2 the lives of the citizens of Missouri, the department of health and
- 3 senior services shall update and verify the accuracy of the information
- 4 on its website as it pertains to social service at least twice annually.

208.1000. Because of the importance of social service programs

- 2 in the lives of the citizens of Missouri, the department of social services
- 3 shall update and verify the accuracy of the information on its website
- 4 as it pertains to MO HealthNet and any other social service programs
- 5 at least twice annually.

217.072. Because of the importance of social service programs in

- 2 the lives of the citizens of Missouri, the department of corrections shall
- 3 update and verify the accuracy of the information on its website as it
- 4 pertains to social service at least twice annually.

376.687. Because of the importance of social service programs in

- 2 the lives of the citizens of Missouri, the department of insurance,
- 3 financial institutions, and professional registration shall update and
- 4 verify the accuracy of the information on its website as it pertains to
- 5 social service at least twice annually.

630.106. Because of the importance of social service programs in

2 the lives of the citizens of Missouri, the department of mental health
