AN ACT

To amend chapter 290, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to labor organization postings.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 290, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 290.585, to read as follows:

290.585. 1. Any employer in Missouri required to post the 2 "Employee Rights Under the NLRA" poster in the workplace pursuant 3 to 29 CFR 104, shall also physically post adequate notice informing 4 employees of their rights under subsection 2 of this section, and 5 provide contact information for the National Labor Relations 6 Board. The department of labor and industrial relations shall develop 7 and display a suitable form setting out language for such notice on its 8 website.

9 2. The notice required under subsection 1 of this section shall 10 contain the following statements:

(a) Employees in Missouri have the right to refuse to join or
affiliate with, to withdraw from, or cease membership in, any labor
union or employee organization of any kind;

(b) Employees in Missouri have the right to refuse to pay certain
dues, fees, assessments, or other charges to any labor union or
employee organization of any kind; and

(c) Employees in Missouri have the right to decertify a union or
other bargaining representative upon compliance with the applicable
provisions of federal law.

20 3. Such notices shall be posted at locations where notices are 21 normally posted or physically disseminated to all employees if no such 22 normal location for posting exists.

4. If compliance by an employer with this section shall pose
significant difficulty or expense, such employer shall be exempt from
compliance with this section.
