JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment to article X of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting one new section relating to a limitation upon state revenue growth.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on

- 2 Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2012, or at a special
- 3 election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted
- 4 to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following
- 5 amendment to article X of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Article X, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adding

thereto one new section, to be known as section 18(f), to read as follows:

Section 18(f). For any fiscal year in which total state revenues

- 2 exceed the total state revenues for the immediately preceding fiscal
- 3 year by seven and one-half percent or more, twenty-five percent of the
- 4 total state revenues in excess of the immediately preceding fiscal year's
- 5 total state revenues shall be refunded pro rata based on the liability
- 6 reported on the Missouri state income tax, or its successor tax or taxes,
- 7 annual returns filed following the close of such fiscal year.
