AN ACT
To authorize the conveyance of property owned by the state in Pettis County to the City of Sedalia.

[^0]Section 1. 1. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered to sell, transfer, grant, and convey a permanent easement over, on, and under property owned by the state in Pettis County to the City of Sedalia. The property is more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING AT THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 5, TOWNSHIP 45 NORTH, RANGE 21 WEST OF THE FIFTH PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN, PETTIS COUNTY, MISSOURI; THENCE N 86 ${ }^{\circ}$ 29'52" $W$ ALONG THE SOUTH LINE OF SAID SOUTHWEST QUARTER, 939 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING OF THE PARCEL CONVEYED TO THE STATE OF MISSOURI IN VOLUME 289 AT PAGE 242 IN THE PETTIS COUNTY RECORDERS OFFICE, AND AS SHOWN ON A SURVEY IN PLAT CABINET B AT PAGE 775 TO THE POINT BEGINNING; THENCE CONTINUING N 86 ${ }^{\circ}$ 29'52"W ALONG SAID SOUTH LINE, 323 FEET TO THE EASTERLY

RIGHT OF WAY OF THE MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY DESCRIBED IN VOLUME 140 AT PAGE 298, AND AS SHOWN ON SAID SURVEY IN PLAT CABINET B AT PAGE 775; THENCE N 2 ${ }^{\circ} 24{ }^{\prime} 46^{\prime \prime}$ E ALONG SAID RIGHT OF WAY, 387.32 FEET; THENCE S $87^{\circ} 36^{\prime} 42^{\prime \prime}$ E, 323 FEET TO THE EAAST LINE OF SAID VOLUME 289 AT PAGE 242; THENCE S $2^{\circ} 24^{\prime} 41^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$ ALONG SAID EAST LINE, 393.60 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 2.9 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, RESERVING TO THE STATE OF MISSOURI INGRESS AND EGRESS TO THE NORTH 2.1 ACRES MORE OR LESS OF THE PARCEL DESCRIBED IN VOLUME 289 AT PAGE 242.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM THE RIGHT OF WAY FOR HIGHWAY Y AS SHOWN ON SAID SURVEY IN PLAT CABINET B AT PAGE 775, AND THE MISSOURI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PLANS FORSTATE HIGHWAYY.
2. The commissioner of administration shall set the terms and conditions for the conveyance as the commissioner deems reasonable. Such terms and conditions may include, but are not limited to, the number of appraisals required, the time, place, and terms of the conveyance.
3. The attorney general shall approve as to form the instrument of conveyance.
