AN ACT

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. 1. The governor is hereby authorized and empowered to sell, transfer, grant, and convey a permanent easement over, on, and 2 3 under property owned by the state in Pettis County to the City of Sedalia.
