## AN ACT

To amend chapter 537, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to products liability.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 537, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 537.763, to read as follows:

537.763. 1. No manufacturer or seller of a product shall be held liable in any product liability action where a proximate cause of the  $\mathbf{2}$ personal injury, death, or damage to property was the material 3 4 alteration of the product by the first or a subsequent purchaser or 5 lessee who was not engaged in the business of either selling such products or using them as component parts of another product to be 6 7 sold; or, in the case of a product which has been remanufactured by a 8 manufacturer, the first or a subsequent purchaser or lessee who was not engaged in the business of either selling such products or using 9 them as component parts of another product to be sold following such 10 11 remanufacture.

12 2. As used in this section, "materially altered" shall mean any 13 alteration which changes the product from the original designed state 14 from the manufacturer or substitution of parts that do not reasonably 15 conform to the manufacturer's specifications, to the extent such 16 specifications have been made available.

This section does not apply to any action to recover damages
for economic loss, personal injury, property damage, or wrongful death

19 arising out of a defective or unsafe condition of any improvement to

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20 real property.
