# AN ACT

To amend chapter 574, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to crimes involving institutions, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 574, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 574.035, to read as follows:

574.035. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as the 2 "House of Worship Protection Act".

2. For purposes of this section, "house of worship" means any
4 church, synagogue, mosque, other building or structure, or public or
5 private place used for religious worship, religious instruction, or other
6 religious purpose.

3. A person commits the crime of disrupting a house of worship8 if such person:

9 (1) Intentionally and unreasonably disturbs, interrupts, or 10 disquiets any house of worship by using profane discourse, rude or 11 indecent behavior, or making noise either within the house of worship 12 or so near it as to disturb the order and solemnity of the worship 13 services; or

(2) Intentionally injures, intimidates, or interferes with or
attempts to injure, intimidate, or interfere with any person lawfully
exercising the right of religious freedom in or outside of a house of

- 17 worship or seeking access to a house of worship, whether by force,
- 18 threat, or physical obstruction.

4. Disrupting a house of worship is a class B misdemeanor. Any
 second offense is a class A misdemeanor. Any third or subsequent
 offense is a class D felony.
